WEATHER

MAY - SEPTEMBER : Temperature ranges from 11°C - 24°C. Sunny days with cool mornings and evenings.

OCTOBER - APRIL : Temperature ranges from 15°C - 35°C. Days are hot & humid with occasional afternoon & evening thunderstorms.

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

MAY - SEPTEMBER : excellent game viewing and not as hot and humid as the summer. Less chance of rain.

NOVEMBER - FEBRUARY : best months to see baby wild animals and for bird watching. Migratory birds start arriving October - November

CLOTHING

Comfortable, casual, cool, cotton bushwear of preferably neutral colours/bush tones. Hats, scarves, warm jacket/windbreaker year round. Comfortable sturdy walking shoes.
